GENERAL INFO

QUALIFICATIONS CLASSES AND HEIGHTS

BRONZE TOUR	100cm
SILVER TOUR	110cm
GOLD TOUR	120cm
DIAMOND TOUR	130-135cm

In the final (April 4-5th) obstacles of each tour will raise 5cm. (For example in the final Bronze Tour will be 105cm; Silver Tour 115cm and etc.)

QUALIFICATION POINTS IN THE STAGES ARE COUNTED

Qualification points are counted as follows:

Ist place 30 points +1 // IInd place 30 points -1 // IIIrd place 30 points -2 and etc.

For example: First place will get 31 points, second place will get 29 points, third place will get 28 points and etc.

FINAL

Everyone can participate in the final. **BUT** points are counted only for riders who have competed in Ist or IInd stage.

For TOP 5 horse-rider combinations of every tour qualification points are converted to money. For example, if a horse-rider combination during all stages collect 90 points and is in the TOP 5 in the final they get prize money + 90 EUR.

IInd day of the final riders compete in reverse order depending on collected number of qualification points (rider who have the highest number of

MAIN RULES

- One horse can have 2 starts per day.
- **If a rider has three or more horses in the same tour class he must to write in entry form NOTES which two horses he choose to collect qualification points.**
- It is allowed to collect qualification points with the same horse in different tours.
- It is allowed to collect qualification points for different riders with the same horse.
- It is mandatory to participate in the final in order to get TOP 5 qualification prize money.
- Jumping without record is allowed except in the final classes with a jump off.

PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

In each competition 5 riders are invited to prize giving ceremony (except open class nr 6;12 – if there are less than 14 horse-rider combinations, 1 or 3 places are awarded and invited) Winner receives a cup, all 5 horses ribbons. Prize money is given for 5 places.

VETERINARY REQUIREMENTS

Horses should have ordered national or valid international passports. Flu vaccination should be valid in accordance with Lithuanian veterinarian requirements (according to manufacturer requirements, once a year). Blood test according Lithuanian State food and veterinary Service requirements, horse blood should be tested against 3 diseases (Equine infectious anemia, Dourine, Glanders) once per year.

RESPONSIBILITY AND INSURANCE

The Organizing Committee and the commissioners will not accept any type of responsibility for material or physical damage, accident or illness which may occur to owners, competitors or grooms, in any circumstance within or out of the competition grounds before, during or after competition. Damage to horses, coaches, saddler,

points is jumping as last number in the class). In case rider have two horses in the same class there must be 15 horse-rider combinations space in the start list.

Coefficient principle of qualification points in the final:

- Bronze/Silver/Gold/Diamond Tour final Ist day qualification points coefficient is 1.
- Bronze/Silver/Gold/Diamond Tour final IInd day qualification points coefficient is 2.

Final results of Champions Tour depends on collected points after two stages and final. In case of the same number of qualification points for two riders - final result depends on the result of final the class!
