



LITHUANIAN OPEN SHOW JUMPING AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP 2017

1. PLACE AND TIME OF THE EVENT

26-27 August , 2017, 11:00 am.

3. PARTICIPANTS

Riders must have the status of an amateur rider (as defined in the 2017 LFF Standing Regulations of Lithuanian Competition Amateur category), who have riding licenses and horse LFF are eligible to participate in the competition. For riders participating in open-class competitions, LFS licenses are optional.

4. ENTRIES

Starting fee is doubled for late submissions.

5. START CHARGES

The starting fee is paid for one start.

Starting fee -15 EUR.

Participants with no competition in class starting fee -10 EUR.

Starting fees are paid in cash at show secretary.

SATURDAY 2017 08 26. Start time at 11:00 am.

Competition No: 1 „Pasažas” shop cup. Two phases.

I group amateur: 80 cm;

II group amateur - 90 cm;

III group amateur - 100 cm.

Competition No: 2 „ Grūda” travel organizer cup. Speed and handiness competition. Art.: 263. Table C.

I group amateur: 85 cm;

II group amateur - 95 cm;

III group amateur - 110 cm.

Gala dinner and results review is scheduled 2 hours after the last competition and awarding ceremony.

SUNDAY 2017 08 27. Start time at 11:00 am

Competition No: 3 „Magrēs baldai“ shop cup.

Art.238.2.2. with a jump off.

I group amateur: 90 cm;

II group amateur - 100 cm;

III group amateur - 120 cm.

Competition No: 4 Open class. „HBH” restaurant cup. Speed and handiness competition.

Art.: 263. Table A.

Obstacles height: 100

Competition No: 5. Diagnostic laboratory „Invitro diagnostika“ cup. Accumulator with increasing difficulty.

Art.269. Table A.

Obstacles height: up to 80 cm.

7. AWARDS

Only Lithuanian citizens are eligible for championship medals and prizes also to be named Lithuanian amateur groups champions and prize-winners. Foreign riders can compete for prize money in the final competitions.

The coach of the champion is awarded with a medal.

Prize money will be available for pay out in cash at the show secretary after the competition.

Prize fund consists of 50% of all collected starting fees.

3 best riders of each competition are invited to the prize giving ceremony. Prize money is allocated according to the distribution table:

8. Event organizers ensure the medical service of the participants.

STABLING: Please submit your requests for horse boxes till 23rd of August by email to juratecivinskaite@yahoo.com

Horse box is 30 EUR for duration of the competition (Friday-Sunday).

Due to limited number of boxes, not all entries can be accepted. Priority will be given to international rider and first entries.

Alternatively, riders can reserve boxes in UAB "Lietuvos žirgynas" stables.

Stable fee is paid at the venue.

9. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

In open class competitions, the rider may participate with an unlimited number of horses (unless it is specifically specified in the program and excluding final competing).

One horse may participate with more than one rider in one or several competitions, however, one horse can participate not more than two classes per day.

In case of 2 riders sharing one horse, second rider does not participate in the championship draw for national classes.

For open class final competition stage, rider must submit maximum of two horses for the draw, and also must participate with set horses first.

10. LIABILITY

The organizers assume no responsibility for the material or physical damage, accidents or illness that the horse owners, athletes or support staff encountered, regardless of whether it happened on or outside the completion area, before, during or after the competition. Damage to horses, coaches, inventory, stables and other assets (including theft or loss) will also not be the responsibility of the organizing committee. We recommend that you take out insurance against these factors and keep your property safe.

11. INSURANCE

All owners and athletes are personally liable for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, agents or their horses. Therefore, we advise to purchase a third-party insurance covering the full amount of the athlete's participation in horse racing competitions within the country and to have this policy valid.

12. PROTESTS

All debates or objections concerning the results of the competition, the application of the rules of the competition should be provided in writing, signed and submitted to the chief judge of the competition not later than 30 minutes after the publication of the particular competition results (FEI General Regulations Art. 163.4.4).

13. ORGANIZER RIGHTS

The organizers reserve the exclusive right, in agreement with the Chamber of Judges, to change the regulations of the competition, depending on the newly emerging circumstances.

14. OTHER ISSUES

All issues not covered by these Regulations before the event or competition will be discussed by the organizers of the event together with the Judicial College in accordance with the FEI Competition Rules and the experience of the competition.
