LITHUANIAN CUP SERIES RULES

Dates: I stage: 2023 06 9-11

II stage: 2023 06 30 - 07 02 Final: 2023 07 28-30

General rules:

- In 6 & 7 years old ranking, the points are collected by combination, in all other rankings, the points are collected by rider;
- Same rider can collect points in multiple rankings with the same or different horse if that is not against the specific ranking rules
- Same rider can collect points in the same ranking class with one or multiple horse but only one best result will count;
- With the same horses multiple rides can collect points, except in 6 & 7 years old horse rankings.

Points calculation:

I place: Number of combinations collectin points + 1
II place: Number of combinations collectin points - 1
III place: Number of combinations collectin points - 2

and so on

The points are only awarded for combinations that completed the route.

Final and Best Rider/Horse:

In the final competition a 1.5x coefficient will be applied. To identify the best rider / combination in each category the points for stages and points from final will be summed up. The rider who wants to become best rider in the ranking must participate in the final competition. Only one horse/rider combination can collect points in the final competition, this combination will start first in the startlist (except in 6-7 years old rankings)

Rankings:

Children Small Tour (100 cm, 105 cm final):

Athletes in this category takes place from the year they reach the age of ten (10) until the end of the year they reach the age of fourteen (14). Horse age: 5yo and older.

1 - 3 place will receive prize in kind

Children Big Tour (115 cm, 120 cm final):

Athletes in this category takes place from the year they reach the age of twelve (12) until the end of the year they reach the age of fourteen (14). Horse age: 5yo and older.

1 - 3 place will receive prize in kind

Amateurs Small Tour (80 cm, 85 cm final):

Amateur riders in accordance to Lithuanian Federation rules for Amateur riders.

1 - 3 place will receive prize in kind



Amateurs Big Tour (100 cm, 105 cm final):

Amateur riders in accordance to Lithuanian Federation rules for Amateur riders.

1 - 3 place will receive prize in kind

Best 6 yo horse (120 cm, 125 cm final):

Athletes in this category takes place from the year they reach the age of sixteen (16). Horse age: 6yo 1 place - 250 EUR, 2 place - 150 EUR, 3 place - 100 EUR

Best 7 yo horse (130 cm, 135 cm final):

Athletes in this category takes place from the year they reach the age of sixteen (16). Horse age: 7yo 1 place – 250 EUR, 2 place – 150 EUR, 3 place – 100 EUR

Best Rider at Grand Prix competition (135 cm, 140 cm final):

Athletes in this category takes place from the year they reach the age of sixteen (16). Horse age: 7yo and older

X. VETERINARY MATTERS

GENERAL

In accordance with the FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse it is imperative that all Horses are physically fit and free from infectious disease before being allowed to compete.

PASSPORTS AND LICENSES

All horses competing in competitions must have a valid passport (National or FEI Passport / FEI Recognition card). Lithuanian riders and their horses must be registered with Lithuanian Equestrian Federation and have valid licenses to participate in the event. Riders and horses that only participate in P level are not required to have licenses.

VACCINATION AND BLOOD TEST

Flu vaccination should be valid in accordance with Lithuanian veterinarian requirements (according to manufacturer requirements, once a year). Blood test according Lithuanian State food and veterinary Service requirements, horse blood should be tested against 3 diseases (Equine infectious anaemia, Dourine, Glanders) once per year.

3. ATSAKOMYBĖ

Equestrian sports involve inherent dangerous risks. 4. INSURANCE

It is your responsibility as an Athlete/Owner/Support Personnel to ensure that you have adequate personal accident insurance in place to cover your participation at Event and in particular to insure against any personal injury or medical expenses arising from an accident, injury or illness which may occur at a show.

As an Athlete/Owner you are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by you, your employees, Support Personnel, your agents or your Horses. You are, therefore, strongly advised to take out third-party liability insurance providing full coverage in relation to Events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date. The Organiser will NOT be responsible for any damage caused to third parties by you, your employees, Support Personnel, your agents or your Horses.



5. BEHAVIOUR AT THE EVENT

The Organizer will not accept sales or offers to sell hay, shavings, straw, feeds, riding equipment or any other items by any other suppliers in the show ground during the show. For any illegal sales, a fine of 100 EUR per offence will be charged. Repeating offence at the Event may lead to exclusion from the Venue. Motors, quads etc. are not allowed in the stable and competition areas.

If allowed at the Event, all dogs must be leashed and affixed to a human or stationary object. Violation of this rule will incur a fine of 80 EUR per offence and, in case of a repeated offence at the Event, may lead to exclusion from the Venue

6. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

By making an entry to the Event Athlete consents to being photographed and/or video recorded by the official Photo/Video team of the Event. Photographs and/or video recordings including images of Athlete, can be used both internally and externally to promote the Event. These images could be used in print and digital media formats including but not limited to print publications, websites, e-marketing, posters, banners, advertising and social media purposes.

7. PRIZE MONEY

All fees and extra costs have to be paid before the departure. All prizes will be paid by Bank Transfer within ten (10) days after the last Competition of the Event provided the Athlete have met all his/her financial and other obligations to the OC.

All Athletes, that won any amount of prize money in addition to accreditation forms, will be asked to fill special tax form that will include necessary details, such as residence address, bank account to which prize money should be paid and etc
